## **RESPONSE TO BIDDER QUESTIONS**

### **Questions - A**

1. In the specifications, there is a requirement for Apprenticeship and Training Program Compliance in the Information for Bidders, page IB-18, paragraph 25.

We are a Building Automation System contractor, and we would sub-contract to an Electrical Contractor for the installation of the control system, and they will meet this criteria, however for our own employees (providing Project Management, Engineering, Software and Checkout) there is no “trade specific apprenticeship and training program” available.

Please confirm that this is acceptable.

Response: A request has been made regarding whether or not an apprenticeship program exists for the type of business/services that are proposed as a subconsultant to the EC. As of this RFI response, we do not yet have a formal interpretation from the state.
