SUPPLEMENTARY INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS - PRE-BID SITE VISIT

This Supplement modifies the Instructions to Bidders. Where any part of the Instructions to Bidders is modified by this supplement, the unaltered provisions of that part shall remain in effect.

2. VISIT TO THE SITE

Change 2.1 to Read:

- 2.1 Prospective bidders will be allowed to visit the job site to take field measurements and examine existing conditions of the project area only during the pre-bid site visit. Prospective bidders are urged to visit the site at this time. Prospective bidders or their representatives attending the pre-bid site visit will not be admitted on facility grounds without proper photo identification. Parking restrictions and security provisions will apply and vehicles will be subject to search.

Bidders are strongly encouraged to visit the project site to assess the following project conditions or quality standards:

1. Site Constraints
2. Existing Conditions

Prospective Bidders must phone a minimum of 24 hours in advance of the pre-bid site visit with the name of the individual who will attend. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, only contractors that schedule a visit prior to the 24-hour advance notification period will be allowed to participate in the Pre-Bid Site Visit. All prospective bidders shall phone Office of General Services, Luanne Vaughn; (607)721-8716, to schedule their Pre-Bid Site Visit.

The Pre-Bid Site Visit will take place on 2/10/2021. There will be 2 separate designated and assigned times for the visit to this project site. Each designated time will allow for groups of 10 or less to enter the facility for the purposes of the Pre-Bid Site Visit. All prospective bidders will be limited to 1 participant each. Each prospective bidder will be assigned a time when they notify NYS Office of General Services of their intent to participate. Prospective Bidders must only attend the site visit session that they are assigned at the time that they call. The designated times are:

02/10/2021 @ 11:45 AM

All Prospective bidders must arrive 10 minutes prior to designated time to complete the Visitor Health Screening. The Health Screening is mandatory for all visitors to this project site. Those who do not pass the Health Screening will not be allowed entry to the project site. All participants shall meet at Building 54 on the facility campus. The Director's Representative will provide all instruction once all attendees are present.

All visitors must comply with the facilities Visitors Safety Policy which is in summary below:

1. All visitors will wear facial coverings for the duration of the visit, even if more than 6' apart.
2. All face coverings will fully cover an individual's nose, mouth and chin.
3. All face coverings must meet CDC and NYS DOH standards.
4. All markings on face coverings must be work appropriate.
5. Visitors must follow all other provisions of face covering and PPE procedures as outlined in CDC or NYS DOH guidance.
6. All visitors must provide their own face coverings for the visit. Those without face coverings will not be allowed to participate in the visit.
7. Strict adherence to hand hygiene signage and utilization of handwashing with soap, water, and disposable paper towels, as well as NYS Hand Sanitizer or a hand sanitizer containing 60% or more alcohol.
8. When using hand sanitizer use safety precautions as it is a flammable substance. Ensure your hands are completely dry before touching metal objects.
9. Adhere to all signage on occupancy limits and social distancing in common areas such as in elevators, bathrooms, meeting rooms, hallways, fleet vehicles, stairwells and other confined spaces.
10. All visits will be kept to a minimum and must follow all facility safety protocols.
11. Ensure physical distancing (at least 6') is maintained whenever practicable.
12. Participants will not be allowed to deviate from the group walk-thru, you must stay with the group for the duration of the visit. All prospective bidders will adhere to the direction given by the Director's Representative at all times during the visit.
13. All visitors shall have a Photo ID readily available at the time of the visit.
