The contractor shall furnish and install all piping and accessories, indicated on the drawing details, between the utility meter and the generator.
 2. The **cost** of bringing the gas from the Utility Gas Main from the street, tapping the main, and furnishing and installing pipe and materials up to the generator site location shall be included in the contractor's price for the project. This work shall be performed by RG&E, **however the cost for this work must be included in the contractor's price and carried by the contractor.**

2. The bidder hereby declares that it has carefully examined all Bidding and Contract Documents and that it has inspected the actual location of the work, together with the local sources of supply, has satisfied itself as to all the quantities and conditions, and understands that in signing this Proposal, it waives all right to plead any misunderstanding regarding the same.
